

CNYJSA COVID 19 GUIDELINES

APRIL 2021

General

In an effort to give players and teams the best possible chance of being able to compete safely during the summer 2021 season CNYJSA is putting forth these recommendations and guidelines.

If any teams decide to withdraw from the league before May 16th the registration fee will be refunded in full. After May 16th a team that withdraws will lose their registration fee.

After June 1st a team that withdraws will face fines as determined by the amount of games that have to be cancelled

Waiver

All players must sign the New York State West Covid Hold Harmless Form. This can be found on www.nyswysa.org under registration - forms. Team coaches are responsible for keeping these signed forms until the season has ended. By allowing a player to participate in a league game the coach is confirming that the player/family has signed a Covid Hold Harmless form and that the coach is in possession of the form.

Coaches / Players / Refs / Spectators (CPRS)

All CPRS must fully abide by any health department quarantine order/recommendations. If you're contacted by the health department and ordered to quarantine you must follow that order until you are cleared.

CPRS that have received a vaccine must still abide by the CNYJSA Covid-19 guidelines.

Mask wearing

Masks are not required when a player or ref is on the field.

All CPRS must wear a mask when they are not on the field (which is defined as the area within the out of bound lines).

All CPRS are asked to social distance a minimum of 6' when not playing

Spectators

Spectators are limited to 2 per player. If a family shows up with two parents and a sibling to watch a game they are in violation of this policy. Please social distance 6' from other families while watching a game.

Coach Responsibility

Each coach is responsible for their players and spectators before, during and after the game.

Referee Responsibility

Referee's are not responsible to enforce any of the CNYJSA Covid-19 guidelines

Breach of Covid Guidelines

If a team or spectators does not follow the CNYJSA Covid-19 guidelines, the coach will be contacted and a warning will be given. Continued violations of the CNYJSA Covid-19 guidelines may result in forfeit/fines of games.

CNYJSA Covid-19 Violations

If a parent feels as though a covid violation should be reported to the league they must do this through their coach or club official.

Coaches, Club Officials and Referee's can report CNYJSA Covid-19 Guideline violations by using our online coaches comment forms. Any forms that are filled out by parents will be ignored.
