

As the 2021 soccer season comes to a close the board of CNYJSA would like to address the past season and share our plans for the upcoming season.

The 2021 spring season proved to be a challenge. The league was only able to get enough teams for (3) divisions. This was due to many different variables: Some teams couldn't secure home fields and decided to play at CNYFSC, some clubs decided to try the conference champions league and some teams decided to play in different private unsanctioned leagues.

The purpose of the CNYJSA league is to serve the local soccer community. It is a "not for profit" league, it is not a business. It will continue if the local soccer community wants it to continue and supports it. If the local soccer community doesn't support the league then it will shut down.

The CNYJSA board is hopeful that 2021 was just a one time situation and the league will continue to have our typical 90-100 teams participating in 2022.

As we prepare for the 2022 season the board is interested in hearing any suggestions member clubs have for changes or improvements. If you are a member club your input is valuable. At the same time, the board will use their experience to decide what changes are feasible and what are not.

We are planning two meetings for member clubs to discuss the 2022 season. Dates can be found on our meeting page and we will announce the location as we get closer to the date.

We will then open registration Jan 1st and close it Feb 15th. After Feb 15th we will review what divisions have enough teams to proceed and what divisions do not. We are doing this early registration so teams will have the ability to join other leagues if we do not have their division.
